SERVICE INFORMATION FROM THE ELDERS

Thursday Evening Socially-Distanced Service at 7p

The Thursday night service, which is the service that will be recorded and posted as the online worship service, will be "socially-distanced." Attendees of the Thursday night service will be required to maintain appropriate distance between household groups and are encouraged to follow the other public health recommendations.

Sunday Morning Hybrid Service at 10:45am

The Sunday morning service will be a hybrid style gathering. The sanctuary will be set aside as a place to worship without social distancing restrictions. The Mission View Room will be set aside as a place to worship with social distancing restrictions. In all common areas of the church, including the foyer, bathrooms, and hallways, we request that you respect the choice of individuals to socially distance.

Feel free to continue worshipping online, or attend one of the two planned in-person services.

SPECIAL PRAYER FOR MISSIONARIES  
PAT & TERRY WOODWARD

We continue to pray for Pat and Terry Woodward as they serve with Resourcing Christian Education International (RCEI). Recently, the Woodwards received troubling medical news about their daughter Kate in Canada, who has a brain tumor on her pituitary gland. Terry was able to gain access into Canada which is difficult under COVID restrictions. Since the tumor is stable and this type is usually benign, they anticipate surgery in 4-8 weeks. Pray that God protects their daughter from any damage from the tumor, especially to her vision. Pray also for Terry to find affordable housing as she awaits Kate's surgery. Finally, pray for the refugee camp on the Island of Lesbos, Greece where Pat & Terry have served in the past and would like to return to serve in the future. Just last week, the first COVID case came to the camp. Then, just a few days ago, a devastating fire ripped through camp Moria displacing over 70% of the 13,000 residents. Pray that God would supply workers and caregivers to offer aid during these difficult times!
